# Saeed Mengal's mother demands CJP intervention

QUETTA - The mother and sister of Saeed Mengal, who was allegedly picked up by the Frontier Corps (FC) men, have demanded the Chief Justice of Pakistan to take notice of illegal detention of Saeed Mengal by the security forces.

Speaking at news conference at Quetta Press Club on Monday, they alleged that the security forces had whisked away Saeed Mengal from Killi Qasim Khan from Dalbandin some one and half year back, who was detained

U Quoli camp, which was can ituriy (BRP) leader, who was recently set free by the agencies.

Saeed was incarcerated in the torture cells and the persecution had badly deteriorated his health, they

added. They further alleged that they had made efforts to approach the inspector general FC but did not succeed. However, an FC official met them and demanded them of paying money in return of Mengal's release, while some other channels had also repeated

the demand, they claimed,

"A person, namely Allah Bakhsh, conveyed the massage of security forces," they said.

They said that Saeed was innocent and if he had committed any crime he must be produced before the court of law so that he could proof his innocence, adding they belonged to a poor

family and were not in a position to pay any 'ransom' (amount) for his release.
