**ORDER**

Raja Abdul Ghafoor, ASC stated that in the case of Munir Sangi, three accused were nominated in FIR out of them Mullan Madad @ Mado Unar who was absconder, has surrendered before the High Court and has succeeded in obtaining protective bail for 15 days and now the investigating agency shall contest his bail plea before the concerned Court. As far as the case in respect of Hadi Bux Sangi, Cameraman of KTN is concerned, a report has been submitted wherein it has been explained that prima facia case under Sections 392, 447 & 506(2) PPC has been made out but the accused Altaf Hussain Unar and Babu Ghulam Sarwar Sial are on bail before arrest granted to them by the Additional Sessions Judge-II, Larkana. According to the learned counsel, the Investigating Agency is contesting the bail granted to them in view of the evidence available to them.

2. Let the Court seized with the matter, concerning bail in both the cases noted herein above, shall disposed of the same in accordance with law, without being prejudiced in any manner from the present proceedings.

3. Since the accused nominated in FIRs have surrendered themselves before the respective Courts, therefore, the law will take its course and the matters shall be decided accordingly, thus no further action is called for by this Court. Needless to observe that the Investigating Agency shall act fairly and independently without causing injustice to either of the parties.

**SUBJECT: MURDER OF KTN CAMERAMAN MUNEEER SANGI**

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above. KTN Cameraman Muneer Sangi was killed on 29.5.2006 in Larkana while performing his professional duty. A Judicial Enquiry was conducted by Mr. Manazir Hussain Zaidi, Additional District & Sessions Judge Larkana, into the aforementioned incident of murder. The I.O. in his report has held following persons directly responsible and involved in committing the murder of Muneer Sangi:

1. Abdul Kareem alias Adju s/o Mullan Madad
2. Mullan Madad alias Madu son of Raza Muhammad, gunman of former Minister Altaf Unnar
3. One unidentified person

Following persons were reported indirectly involved in the incident:

1. Altaf Uner, former Minister
2. Dr. Akhtar Ali Dayo, Senior Medical Officer, C.M.C Larkana
3. Irfan Ali Baloch, then DPO Larkana
4. Abdul Kareem Khoso, then S.P. (Investigation) Larkana
5. Mohammad Yousuf Rind, then TPO Saddar Larkana
6. Allah Jurio Khokhar, then TIP Saddar Larkana
7. Safdar Ali Abbasi, then SHO Taluka P.S. Larkana
8. Mohammad Ayaz Khero, SIP P.S. Taluka Larkana.

2. The Honourable Chief Minister has directed that disciplinary action and criminal proceedings against the accused person as per the Report of Enquiry Officer be initiated.

## SUMMARY FOR CHIEF MINISTER SINDH

SUBJECT: JUDICIAL ENQUIRY INTO MURDER OF KTN  
CAMERAMAN MUNEEER SANGI.

KTN Cameraman Muneer Sangi was killed on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2006 in Larkana while performing his professional duty. It was desired by the then Minister for Home Sindh to conduct an Enquiry into the matter to find out the facts of murder as well as to windup the agitation of Journalists during the Provincial Assembly Sessions. Accordingly, in consultation with District & Sessions Judge, Larkana, Mr. Manazir Hussain Zaidi, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Larkana was appointed as Inquiry Officer to conduct the judicial enquiry into the murder of KTN Cameraman Muneer Sangi, with following terms of reference of Enquiry( Annexure-I):-

- (i) To probe and ascertain the circumstances and causes leading to the death of Muneer Sangi KTN Cameraman.
- (ii) To fix the responsibility and recommend the action to be taken against responsible persons directly or indirectly involved in the incident.

2. Inquiry Officer has furnished his detailed report(Annexure-II). In respect of Term No.(i), I.O. has reported that Muneer Sangi who by profession was cameraman of KTN (Kawish Television Net Work) on 29.5.2006 had received telephonic message about cross firing in between Uner and Abro tribes, he took his camera and boarded in a private car alongwith his relative and reached at village Baqapur and started video recording. Three accused, who were carrying weapon in their hand, and one accused instigated his son for killing the cameraman Muneer Sangi and in pursuance of instigation his son made firing toward Muneer Sangi which resulted in causing his death.

Whereas, in respect of Term No. (ii), I.O. has reported that from the facts placed on records it has been established from all four corner that following accused are directly responsible and involved in committing murder of KTN Cameraman Muneer Sangi:-

- (a) Abdul Kareem alias Adlu s/o Mullan Madad alias Madu (under trial).
- (b) Mullan Madad alias Madu son of Raza Muhammad (absconder) who is Gun man of Mr. Altaf Uner, Provincial Minister Sindh and
- (c) One unidentified.

4. Following persons are involved indirectly in the incident:

1. Altaf Uner Provincial Minister.
2. Dr. Akhtar Ali Dayo, Senior Medical Officer (under suspension) Chandka Medical College Larkana.
3. Irfan Ali Baloch the then DPO, Larkana.
4. Abdul Kareem Khoso the then S.P.(Investigation) Larkana.
5. Mohammad Yousuf Rind the then TPO Saddar Larkana.
6. Allah Jurio Khokhar TIO Saddar Larkana.
7. Safdar Ali Abbasi Inspector, the then SHO Taluka P.S. Larkana.
8. Mohammad Ayaz Khero SIO P.S. Taluka Larkana.

5. The Inquiry Officer has recommended the following actions as per Term No.(ii):-

- (a) Altaf Uner, Provincial Minister may be directed produce/surrender the accused Mullan Madad alias Madu Uner the trial court, where 193 Cr.P.C. application is pending against the said accused filed by the complainant and notices are returned unserved. In case Altaf Uner failed to surrender the accused, proceedings under section 216 PPC be initiated against him or any other action which Government of Sindh deem fit.
- (b) There remains no doubt that it is clear case of mal-administration on the part of following Government servants, therefore, I.O. recommended for initiating disciplinary proceedings against the Government servants except officer at Sr. No. 01 against whom disciplinary proceedings are already pending before the Chief Secretary to Government of Sindh. It is also recommended Criminal Proceedings against the all six Government servants be initiated under section 201 r/w section 34 PPC:-



In the light of above recommendations of Inquiry Officer, proposed that concerned departments/competent authorities of Government's Officers may be advised to take disciplinary action and criminal proceedings may also be initiated u/s 201 r/w section-34 of PPC against those who do not comply with the said recommendations in letter and spirit. Besides, Mr. Altaf Uner, Provincial Minister may be directed through Chief Secretary Sindh to produce/surrender the accused Mullan Madad alias Madu Uner in the trial where 193 Cr.P.C. application is pending against the said accused filed by complainant and notices are returned unserved. In case Mr. Altaf Uner fails to surrender the accused, the proceedings under section 216 PPC be initiated against him.

The undersigned conducted enquiry into the subject matter.

Accused Madad Ali may be tried and assessed by placing at the disposal of session court.


The Session court may invoke the jurisdiction of 193 CrPC by taken cognizance of the evidence put forth by both parties because the evidence put forth by the complainant is strong. Simple absence of accused from site does not absolve him from the liability of criminal conspiracy. He is the main partner in the conflict of UNNER/ABRA tribal dispute. Even the witness of alibi may be interested.

Investigation Branch of Larkana did not take cartridges from the site as stated by DPO Larkana. He i-e DPO him self has taken the cartridges after lapse of days.

Therefore, it is in fitness of things that evidence put forth by both parties may be put to court as police is agency of collecting evidence and assessment of evidence is jurisdiction of court.

In upper Sindh, Journalists are being threatened to death because they report the illegalities of tribal feudal system. They need more protection. The gangsters don't want that their misdeeds may be reported and taken cognizance by the law.

The undersigned checked the cases of conflict between UNNER/ABRA, all cases have been challaned in under section 512 CrPC as absconders. Where the law will prevail, finally ending in JIRGA bartering the money with human lives
