Finalised candidates for the Supreme Court Law Clerkship Program 2022

This year, the Supreme Court Law Clerkship Program received the highest number of applications since its inception, with over 850 young lawyers from all across Pakistan applying for the limited eleven positions of law clerks.

The majority of the applications went above and beyond the minimum stipulated criteria and 46 exceptional applicants were shortlisted solely on the basis of merit. These 46 applicants were then interviewed by two Honourable Judges of the Supreme Court.

The young men and women who were selected are from all parts of Pakistan and have received highly diverse educations.
